WASMA - What do we do? What were we created for?

WASMA is the WA peak body for modified street cars. We were created in 2020 by a group of enthusiasts and we're here to give a voice to owners of modified cars in dealings with the WA government and other peak bodies.

We work for clubs to help with the C4C and Code 404 concessional licence schemes. We've created an App to simplify club's management and operation of C4C and help clubs maximise the days their members can use their cars.

We want to continue to work with the DoT to improve understanding and working relations to get the best consistency and flexibility for owners of modified cars to showcase their skill and creativity.

What have we achieved so far?

- Helped implement the rollout of C4C to clubs
- Created a great App for C4C open runs for everyone, club runs for clubs only, totals up use, helps admin
- Worked with clubs to help their members use as many Club and Personal C4C days possible
- Collaborated with the ASMF-WA who developed a Modified Vehicle Working Group with the DoT that
 enables all stakeholder to discuss options for modified vehicles that don't meet the VSB14 guidelines
- Working hard to create strong trust and communication with other peak bodies to benefit owners of classic street cars and find areas where common good can be achieved
- Created a Stamp Duty Working Group to make approaches to government asking to grant an exemption to stamp duty matching all other states (except Qld)

Who is involved?

- Passionate car people started WASMA and are committed to helping it succeed. We're all volunteers with nothing to gain personally from our efforts.
- Our President is a Summernats Grand Champion, our Technical Committee is led by a Ridler Great 8
 Award winner. We have many of the best modified car builders in WA and some of the largest car clubs leaders involved. We include in our membership the guys who worked hard for a long time to get us C4C.

How do we operate?

- We have a small executive and management committee group to run meetings and manage things we welcome everyone to come along and be part of it. Any attendee can have input.
- Clubs are encouraged to bring ideas and issue along to meetings and they get to vote on all decisions
- Committees are created to tackle issues, anyone wishing to be involved can help
- We're a not-for-profit organisations with volunteer members, our focus is not to sit on large cash reserves, only enough in case we need legal or engineering support
- Member-clubs get access to the App to run their C4C admin and operation. The data is kept safe and secure, clubs can check their members use any time.

What do we need now?

- We need more clubs to join us the more people we represent, the stronger our voice will be heard
- We need your ideas on what needs to be done next we want people to get involved with their passion, tell us what needs doing, and work with us to achieve it
